Participants: 12 participants. 6 male and 6 female, two per country/district, and additional participants from a country or district if others decline to send a participant.

Note: Traditional Norwegian food. Please let us know if there are any food restrictions.

Age group: 17 - 19

Language: English

Participation fee: EUR 450

Own costs: Pocket money, personal travel expenses to and from Oslo Airport Gardermoen, insurance, and visa fees if necessary.

Insurance: Participants must be insured against illness, accidents, and third-party liabilities according to Rotary International recommendations. Proof of insurance must be sent to the camp coordinator before arrival.

Application: Applications will be considered in order of being received. The application, using a regular short-term exchange form, must be sent by a certified district. The application must be endorsed and signed by the sponsoring Rotary Club and the District Youth Exchange Officer.
