LOCATION Hoogstraten and Turnhout and surrounding cities in the Dutch speaking part of Belgium

PARTICIPANTS 17-19 years old

GROUP SIZE max 20 participants (boys and girls)

LANGUAGE knowledge of English is essential

CAMP FEE € 300,00 (bank transfer after approval of your application, but before May, 31)

ADDITIONAL COSTS Travel expenses + insurance.
All accommodation including food and beverages are covered by our organisation. You will need pocket money to cover personal expenses during the stay.

ARRIVAL - DEPARTURE Brussels National Airport (Zaventem) (BRU) / Eindhoven (EIN) or Antwerp Central Station (train).
There will be no pick-up or drop-off at Charleroi Airport (CRL or BrusselsSouth Airport)!

HOSPITALITY INSURANCE The participants will be hosted by Rotarian families.
In accordance with Rotary International recommendations for Short Term Exchange Program (STEP). Possible individual requirements for non-European participants.
Proof of insurance to be sent after acceptance, but before arrival.

WEATHER CONDITIONS August should offer agreeable temperatures, but do not forget your rain gear. Best to check the weather before you pack.



DRESS CODE Easy and casual dressing. Sport-, bike- and walking activities are part of the program, so please bring sneakers, shorts and swimwear.

DIET Dietary requirements or special requests will be taken into account as much as possible.

APPLICATION You can enroll for this camp until April 30, 2026. First-in, first-serve rule will be applied. Only accurate and complete application forms accompanied with a motivation letter in English will be considered. We aim to accept one candidate per nationality.

NOTE The camp fee should be paid upon acceptance of your application. You should provide your travel schedule before June 30, 2026. If not your application will be cancelled and a candidate from our waiting list will take your place.
