



Fee

Camp fee is 600 Euro
All meals, accommodation, transfers and museum fees are included in the fee. Travels to and from Turkiye and pocket money is at participant's own expense

Necessary Equipment

Participants should bring their personal medication (if any), trekking boots, rucksack, long and short trekking trousers, warm jackets for nights, swim suits, one formal suit for flag ceremony, hat, sunglasses, sun protection cosmetics and pocket money for personnel expenses. Each participant should bring 7 small size club flags or banners. Participants are required to have whatsup application loaded in their cell phones for communication during the camp
