

📍 Agra – Mughal Marvel

Agra is a city on the banks of the Yamuna River in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. With a population of roughly 1.6 million, Agra is the fourth-most populous city in Uttar Pradesh and the twenty-third most populous city in India. Agra's notable historical period began during Sikandar Lodi's reign, but the golden age of the city began with the Mughals. Agra was the foremost city of the Indian subcontinent and the capital of the Mughal Empire.

📍 Manali – Trek for an Adventurous Finale

Manali is a premier, high-altitude hill station (2,050 m) in Himachal Pradesh's Kullu district, known as the "Valley of the Gods". Nestled on the Beas River, it is a popular year-round destination for skiing, trekking, and, as a, gateway to Lahaul, Spiti, and Ladakh.

Week 2 - The Trekking Week

During the second week, participants will embark on a journey to the breathtaking hill station of Manali. Nestled at the valley's end, Manali is not only one of Himachal Pradesh's most stunning tourist destinations but also a place of international repute. The town is a paradise of gushing streams, melodious birdsong, dense forests, flourishing orchards, and the majestic sight of snow-capped peaks.

From Manali, we will set off on a five-day trek to Deo Tibba Base Camp. Deo Tibba trek is a pleasant trek that takes us to the grazing pastures of the Gaddi shepherds and the emerald blue waters of the Chandertal Lake (4,480 m) with magnificent views of Deo Tibba peak (6,001 m) and its huge hanging glaciers. This is a spectacular view that haunts every trekker giving a unique experience. It attracts not only climbers to ascend its snowy summits, but also trekkers, due to the beautiful trail that leads to its base.

The walk is a gentle ramble through forests and meadows. This excursion presents the lush green Kullu valley in all its grandeur. This scenic, summer high-altitude trek winds its way through lush green meadows and alpine forests. With memorable views of snow-capped peaks, including Indrasan, Inderkilla, Deo-Tibba and Hamta Pass, this is one of the most scenic treks in Himachal Pradesh. Mountain streams, glaciers, and log bridges... all go into making this a trek worth experiencing.


