





Dear Rotarians, Rotary Clubs and friends of Rotary International,

A little over two years ago, a Ukrainian-American named Andrew (Andrij) Lenec arrived in Ukraine from Colorado to begin his service in the United States Peace Corps as an NGO Advisor. Upon completing his in-country training, he was providentially assigned to work with the Rotary Club of Truskavets, Ukraine, where he could put his language and cultural skills, his passion for working with youth, and his 25+ years as a Rotarian in the United States to work.

A vision and a mission quickly arose for Andy; specifically, to create an International Youth Conference in Ukraine. This conference would bring together youth from the United States, Ukraine and other countries with the goal of promoting harmonious international cooperation between the future leaders who attend the event. Andy had observed that young leaders learn best from each other, especially in international settings, and thus he began his work in the Peace Corps, which quickly spread from Truskavets to other Rotary Clubs in Ukraine. With the encouragement and support of District Governor Serhii Zavadsky, the project evolved to include a reintroduction of the RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Award) program in Ukraine. More importantly, this vision spread to other Peace Corps volunteers, enabling it to live on after Andrij's service in Ukraine ended, and when current volunteer Shannon Carter took up the mantle of project leadership.

The vision is now a reality. Rotary District 2232, encompassing Ukraine and Belarus, and Peace Corps volunteer Shannon Carter and her team are pleased to invite you to participate in the first Ukraine International Youth Conference, which will take place this summer in Lviv, Lvivska Oblast, in western Ukraine, from July 22nd – July 27, 2019. As with other RYLA programs throughout the world, our conference will bring together young adults to study and perfect skills such as leadership, volunteerism, communication, public speaking, conflict resolution and team building, to name just a few, plus it will offer a fascinating glimpse into Ukraine's rich culture and history.

We are inviting youth leaders ages 15–19 from the United States and other countries to come and meet their counterparts from Ukraine – to share strategies, explore each other's culture, and to learn new skill sets from each other and from the best youth trainers and moderators available from the participating countries and partner groups. Conference participants may be selected from Interact and Rotaract Clubs, or from the communities that Rotary Clubs serve.

The cost of the RYLA Ukraine conference is extremely reasonable in US terms at \$360 per person. This includes conference fees, supplies, food and lodging, in-country transportation, and all excursions and cultural events.

Airfare to and from Ukraine is not included, but is also fairly reasonable and convenient via several carriers. The best city to fly into would be Lviv. We will provide assistance with ground transportation from your airport of arrival to the venue.
