



To Arthur Frederick Sheldon**

At the recent district assembly of Rotary International, 2005 distinguished held in Kingston an award was bestowed on Mrs. Arthur F. Sheldon.

The Chicago Club, chapter 1, in joined in presenting the award to pay tribute to the memory of her late husband, Arthur F. Sheldon. Following are the tributes:

At the first convention of Rotary Clubs in 1905, Sheldon made a speech which was well received by the delegates from the various clubs. It was the first step toward the ideal which they were helping to realize.

During the first year of the club's existence, Mr. Arthur F. Sheldon served as chairman of its business methods committee (sub-branches, executive committee) and at the second year as chairman of the committee which contrived an address which still serves as a guide to the importance of the ideal of service in the lives of all Rotarians.

In that address he again mentioned the name of the first convention the words:

"Arthur F. Sheldon, who with the words 'Service Above Self' by George Washington, became the motto of the Rotary organization."

He also said that he could not repeat the words which he said at that time, that he should like to desire to be of service to the world.

He was a man of great compassion which invariably manifested itself in his



APPLICATION FROM CLUB FOR MEMBERSHIP

To the Secretary, Rotary International, Chicago, U. S. A.:

The Rotary Club of Zagreb of the State or Kingdom of Yugoslavia,
Province of Slovenia
having been duly organized on 6. march, 1929,
with 26 charter members, each representing a different classification of whom

a roster list is hereto attached, now applies for membership in

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL

in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of Rotary International, which are hereby ratified by this club and the following

understandings and agreements:

- As our Constitution, we have adopted the Standard Club Constitution for Rotary Clubs, copy of which, authenticated by the signatures of the president and secretary of our club, is attached herewith, together with copy of the By-Laws adopted by this club. No change in, or amendment to, the club's Constitution herewith submitted, nor any amendment to the club's By-Laws which will conflict with the Constitution of the club or with the Constitution and By-Laws of Rotary International, will be made without first submitting the same to the secretary of Rotary International for approval by its Board of Directors.
- This club will be bound by any and all amendments to the Standard Club Constitution which may be adopted hereafter as provided in Article I, Section 3, of the By-Laws of Rotary International, and in Article XI of the Constitution of this club.
- This club will remit payment for its members' subscriptions to THE ROTARIAN as provided for in the club By-Laws upon receipt of invoice covering such subscriptions. (An obligation of membership in the United States, Canada, and Newfoundland. Elsewhere—voluntary.)
- NO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS will be elected until this club has received official notice of its election to membership in Rotary International. Thereafter this club will steadily though carefully add to its membership, but during the first year of its existence NOT MORE THAN THREE NEW members will be introduced into the club DURING ANY CALENDAR MONTH.
- During the same period this club will not establish any classification not included in Rotary's "Outline of Classifications," unless it has the written approval of the District Governor (or, in the case of a non-districted club, of the Secretary of Rotary International).

And furthermore, in our desire to develop true Rotarians and a Rotary club observing certain fundamentals that will make of it a properly functioning unit, this club is hereby pledged to maintain the following

fundamental characteristics of Rotary:

- The classification principle of membership.
- Attendance, at least in the required minimum for continuance of membership.
- Fellowship, in the establishment of intimate and lasting friendships.
- The use of the club meeting in the making of broader and better business men—in training men more capable of rendering service in their vocations and in the community in which they live.
- The requirement that members strive for the betterment of their craft, particularly stressing higher business standards and practices.
- An obligation to do effective but non-duplicative service in their community, state or province and country.
- Service to humanity.

Attached hereto is remittance amounting to \$100.00, U. S. Currency, covering the charter fee as provided in Article I, Section 2, of the By-Laws of Rotary International.
