

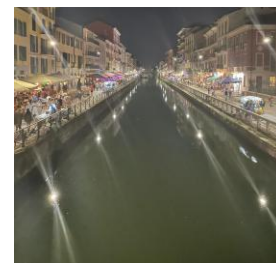


Milan, Italy
